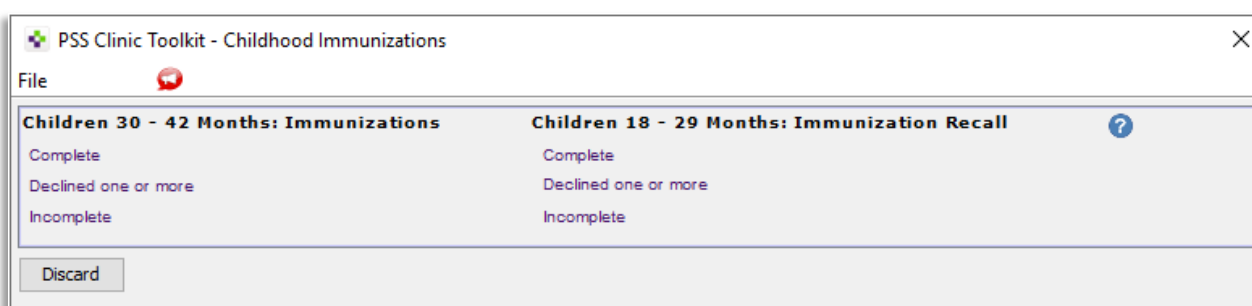

EMR and Data Entry Requirements

EMR knowledge prerequisites:

- Familiarity with recall tools within the EMR

Each report in the toolkit has specific data requirements in addition to the following:

- Patient charts must be assigned to a provider
- Accurate "Active" status of patient charts (Active status includes rostered and non-rostered patients)

Children 30-42 Months: Immunizations

i4C Indicator PHC-IMM-001: Patient Care Childhood Immunizations v 2.0

Category: Preventive Health Care/Immunizations

The **Patient Care: Childhood Immunization** indicator is based on the **AFHTO** indicator framework, version D2D 5.0 v1 Jun 2017.

Indicator Definition: Patients aged 30 to 42 months (inclusive) who have received all ministry-supplied immunizations as recommended by the National Advisory Committee on immunizations.

Purpose: Use to recall patients who have NOT completed routine childhood immunizations.

Suggested use: Review of patient charts in the Incomplete search, may be helpful in ensuring that you are able to get patients up to date with their immunization schedule.

Base Population: 'Active' Demographic Status, age 30 - 42 months

Metric Criteria:

Complete: WITH all the following complete:

- 4 instances of DTaP-IPV-Hib
- 3 instances of Pneumococcal conjugate
- 1 instance of Meningococcal Conjugate C
- 1 instance of Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- 1 instance of Varicella

Incomplete: WITHOUT all the following complete:

- 4 instances of DTaP-IPV-Hib
- 3 instances of Pneumococcal conjugate
- 1 instance of Meningococcal Conjugate C
- 1 instance of Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- 1 instance of Varicella

AND WITHOUT a documented refusal for any of the above in the past 12 months.

Declined one or more: WITHOUT all the following complete:

- 4 instances of DTaP-IPV-Hib
- 3 instances of Pneumococcal conjugate
- 1 instance of Meningococcal Conjugate C

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- 1 instance of Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- 1 instance of Varicella

AND WITH a documented refusal for any of the above in the past 12 months.

Children 18-29 Months: Immunizations Recall

i4C Indicator PHC-IMM-002: Patient Care Childhood Immunizations Recall v 2.0

Category: Preventive Health Care/Immunizations

The **Patient Care: Childhood Immunization** 18-29 months (inclusive) is modified from the **AFHTO** indicator framework, version D2D 5.0 v1 Jun 2017.

Indicator Definition: Patients aged 18 to 29 months (inclusive) who have received all ministry-supplied immunizations as recommended by the National Advisory Committee on immunizations.

Purpose: Use to recall patients who have NOT completed routine childhood immunizations by their 30th month of age.

Suggested use: Review of patient charts in the Incomplete search, may be helpful in ensuring that you are able to get patients up to date with their immunization schedule.

Base Population: 'Active' Demographic Status, age 18-29 months (inclusive)

Metric Criteria:

Complete: WITH all the following complete:

- 4 instances of DTaP-IPV-Hib
- 3 instances of Pneumococcal conjugate
- 1 instance of Meningococcal Conjugate C
- 1 instance of Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- 1 instance of Varicella

Incomplete: WITHOUT all the following complete:

- 4 instances of DTaP-IPV-Hib
- 3 instances of Pneumococcal conjugate
- 1 instance of Meningococcal Conjugate C
- 1 instance of Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- 1 instance of Varicella

AND WITHOUT a documented refusal for any of the above in the past 12 months.

Declined one or more: WITHOUT all the following complete:

- 4 instances of DTaP-IPV-Hib

- 3 instances of Pneumococcal conjugate
- 1 instance of Meningococcal Conjugate C
- 1 instance of Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- 1 instance of Varicella

AND WITH a documented refusal for any of the above in the past 12 months.
